1 8. At all times herein mentioned, defendant, ANTON BILCHTK, M.D., was and is
2 a medical doctor with offices at CENTURY CITY HOSPITAL. At all times herein
3 mentioned, ANTON BTLCHIK., M.D. had hospital privileges at CENTURY CITY
4 HOSPITAL and provided medical care and treatment to the Plaintiffs Decedent,
5 CARLOS GERMAN at said hospital.

6 9. Plaintiffs are informed and believe, and hereby allege, that defendants, ANTON
7 BILCHIK, BRADLEY LANDIS, M.D., and DOES 1 through 10, inclusive, at all times
8 relevant hereto, were and are physicians duly licensed to practice medicine in the State of
9 California

10 10. Defendants and DOES 1 through 20, and each of them, undertook the care and
11 treatment of the plaintiffs' decedent, CARLOS GERMAN, and rendered professional
12 services in the diagnosis, care and treatment of plaintiffs' decedent beginning on or about
13 March 27, 2004, and continuing thereafter.

14 **II.** At the date and time of the aforesaid, the defendants, and each of them, failed to
15 exercise the proper degree of knowledge and skill and so negligently, carelessly,
16 recklessly, wantonly, and unlawfully treated, provided care, monitoring, examination and
17 other professional services, in that, among other things, they failed to properly diagnose
18 and treat plaintiffs' decedent resulting in plaintiffs' decedent's death on March 30, 2004.

19 12. All of the injuries sustained by decedent, CARLOS GERMAN, as more
20 specifically alleged below, occurred in the CCH facility located in Los Angeles,
21 County of Los Angeles, State of California.

22 13. As a direct and proximate result of the negligence, carelessness, recklessness,
23 wantonness, and unlawfulness of defendants, and each of them, and the resulting incident
24 as aforesaid, Plaintiffs sustained injury to their persons, all to Plaintiffs' damage in a sum
25 within a jurisdiction of this court and to be shown according to proof.
